

What must we do to be saved?

What do we find?

◆ Repentance

- 2 Cor 7:10 (ASV) For godly sorrow worketh repentance **unto** salvation ...

◆ Confessing Christ

- Rom 10:10 (ASV) ... with the mouth confession is made **unto** salvation.

◆ Baptism

- Acts 2:38 (ASV) ... be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ **unto** the remission of your sins; ...

What must we do to be saved?

◆ What do we find?

- Repentance unto salvation (2 Cor.)
- Confession unto salvation (Rom.)
- Be baptized unto the remission of sins (Acts)

Exactly the same word in English (**unto**)
and Greek (ei~)

***All three must be equally necessary!
Only when all three are completed does
one have salvation.***

When do we become a saved person?

- ◆ Salvation is “in Christ” (2 Tim. 2:10).
- ◆ Christ saves only His body (Eph. 5:23).
- ◆ How do we get “into” Christ?
 - There are two (and only two) Scriptures that have the expression “into Christ” or “into Jesus.”
 - Will we let the Scriptures (and not men) teach us how to get “into Christ”?

When do we become a saved person?

◆ Those two Scriptures are:

- Rom 6:3 Or do you not know that as many of us as were **baptized** into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?
- Gal 3:27 For as many of you as were **baptized** into Christ have put on Christ.

◆ It is the act of baptism that puts a person **into** Christ.

- A person who has not been baptized **into** Christ is not "**in** Christ."
- A person who is not "in Christ" is not saved.
